When did it happen? March 13, 2008

How many people came: 318

Who attended: children at risk, parents; street young people

Where did it take place: Juan Pablo II and Claret, Bogotá, Colombia



About 300 children, young people and adults came in our feeding program in Juan Pablo II. We had a time of singing and some of the children of Pacto en Acción gave a presentation of gospel music presentation through a dance. The gospel was presented by meditating on what the Jesus has done for us. The sharing of the Word was ended in presenting Jesus as a living God. Some children prayed the prayer of acceptance. The children were given an illustrated book of The Life of Jesus.

On the street outreach in Claret, 18 street young people were served. The gospel was presented through the story of the Prodigal Son. The young people prayed but only God knows the sincerity of their hearts. When we were about to serve spaghetti, bread and pop, 12 policemen came wanting to take the young people. By talking to them, they agreed for us to serve the food with words that everybody will leave the park after eating. We were also asked not to come back.
