Dear Praying Friend,



Our children of 2003 are now young men and women. And it is time for our young men to render their services to the government. One already finished his obligation last year and is now continuing his studies in Bible school, Javier. At present there are three young men who are rendering their services, two in military service and one in police service. Please pray for God's protection for these young men: Brayan, Jose Luis and Andres.

Because of his Bible school training, Javier's service for the Lord is improving a lot. He is now assisting our pastor. Last month, he started preaching once a month in our mid-week Worship Service. He will also be our main speaker on our evangelistic camp on June 28 and 29. Please pray that the Lord will continue to mold him as a vessel for His ministry.



About the camp: The theme of the camp is: Jesus, My Savior. Our prayer is that the 25 kids that we will bring will come to know Jesus as their personal Savior and Lord.

Because it will only be a two-day camp, our schedule will be hectic. We will be leaving Ciudad Bolivar at 5 in the morning of June 28. Javier divided the plan of salvation in three sessions: Jesus Loves and Forgives Me; Jesus, I Need You; and I Have Eternal Life and I Live for Christ.

On every camp we see to it that the children have a lot of fun. They not only study the Bible and memorize verses; there are times of handwork, recreation and demonstrating their talents also.

Please pray with us as we (the five camp staff) prepare for this camp. As I am writing this letter, we still need \$950 for this camp. Please pray also for the finances.

The children in the ministry center are so grateful to God for the building He has given us. Last month they suggested that we spend an afternoon for general cleaning. We scheduled a general cleaning and a lot children and young people came and cleaned not only the building but also the chairs and tables. They said they did it for Jesus.

Please continue to pray with us for God's provision so the building can be completely finished.



In our everyday work with children, we not only help them in their school work and helping them to read and write but most especially to introduce them to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. According to Alex: "Before I came to know Jesus I was disobedient and for this reason, my mother was always angry with me. I realized that I needed Jesus for I felt alone and worried and I had sadness in my heart. I surrendered my life to Jesus. Now He is the One who is helping me to be obedient and to always pray and read my Bible. My

life now is very different from before I accepted Jesus. My mother is now very happy because I am now an obedient child."

My prayer is that we will never transgress in our goal for the ministry: to evangelize and disciple children, young people and adults.

I want to thank you for your faithfulness in prayers and financial support. You have a great part in the ministry of Pacto en Acción. May the Lord richly bless you.
