One of the occasions that the children are looking forward to is Mothers' Day. On May 9, we had a special Worship Service dedicated to mothers. One of the children, Alejandra, read an appreciation letter for all the mothers. Each child gave a rose and a card that they prepared for their mother. Rosalie, the short term missionary who is helping me in the ministry, prepared caramel candies and were also given to the mothers. The mothers went home very happy knowing that they are very much



the ministry.

In my previous prayer letters, I asked your prayers for God to send another missionary to help in the ministry. April a short term missionary arrived and been helping me in the ministry in Ciudad Bolivar, Pacto en Accion. She is a great help, encouragement and moral support.

She will only be staying till March next year, so, please continue to pray for more missionaries to come to Colombia to help us in

June 3, we started a feeding program for 100 children at the ministry center. At present, we are giving lunch twice a week and as the Lord provide, we will add more days each week. The children who are studying in the afternoon are coming in the morning for Bible class and receive help in their school assignments. They eat their lunch before they go to school. Those whose schedule is in the morning come straight from school to have their lunch and then their regular class at the ministry center.



When I asked several mothers how this program is helping them, their answer was: “It is always a problem to give a substantial food for my children. We consider it as a blessing from God.”

Mothers themselves who benefit for this program are helping in cooking. We have to start preparing very early for we start serving lunch at 11:30, so, children who are in the afternoon classes can leave at 12 noon.



Every last Wednesday of the month, we are celebrating the birthdays of the children. In the May celebration, it was Javier who gave the teaching on I Samuel 16. He emphasized that contrary to humans who look on the outside appearance, God looks on our hearts. The children prayed that God will always be pleased in the attitude of their hearts.

Please continue to pray for Javier in his studies in the Bible school as God prepares him for a greater task. He told me that he is willing to obey God’s will in his life especially in the ministry and asked for prayers.

Thank you so much for your continuous partnership in the ministry. May the Lord richly bless you.

I will be sharing with you about the camp on my next prayer letter. Pray also for the completion in the construction of the ministry center: the need for the classroom divisions, cabinets and the third floor.
