



2014 SPECIAL NEEDS RESOURCE ROOM

As part of our goal to reach the most vulnerable children, we opened a special needs resource room at our school, Jesus is the Truth Nursery and Primary School. On an hourly basis, the room is churning with activity as children with behavioral challenges or learning disabilities come for extra coaching, and children with physical disabilities are brought in for physical or occupational therapy during the school day. The focus of our program is equipping Ugandans to care for those with disabilities within their own communities. Every day is filled with coaching one of my Ugandan counterparts to do the therapy, activity, or lesson, setting them up to continue on independently. The resource room includes a therapy corner with privacy curtains, a sensory board (constructed from local materials by an intern), various fine motor activities, etc. We have seen huge gains in some of these children who would otherwise have been rejected as “unteachable.”
