### A Future AND A HOPE

**THE SMALL ISLAND** nation of Sri Lanka, off the coast of India, has struggled to recover from a lengthy civil war, a current economic crisis and unprecedented levels of inflation. At the same time, only 1.3% of Sri Lankans are evangelical Christians. Pastors planting churches in the rural areas must depend on the offerings of the believers in their churches, many of whom are struggling to provide for their own families. Funds are scarce.

Because of inflation, education costs have soared. Parents who cannot afford to send their children to school have stopped sending them. How can pastors manage the luxury of their children's education when some of them must work part time just to provide the basic needs for their families?

Fifteen-year-old Edwin\* is the son of a pastor who planted a church in a Buddhist village notoriously known as a center for drugs and filled with drug dealers and

addicts. Edwin is a brilliant student who received sponsorship funds through one of ACTION's ministries, enabling him to attend high

school. He has excelled in his studies and recently received the award for being the school's best student.

Several pastors' children, like Edwin, have been blessed through sponsorship, giving them hope as they look



toward the future. Investing in the education of these bright, capable young believers is having a lasting impact on their lives. But the impact goes beyond the children themselves. These children and youth are growing into well-equipped young leaders for the church in Sri Lanka and have the potential to become incredible assets for the nation. Just imagine what God can do with a faithful, educated generation, zealous for the Kingdom of God!
