I am presently in the middle of a very busy season of promotional travel. I recently returned from Missionsfest Alberta in Edmonton. I have upcoming conferences over the next month in Edmonton (youth workers conference—March 1&2), Fort St. John (March 8&9), and Prairie Bible College (March 13&14). **Do pray for meaningful interactions at each event and for solid follow ups of people interested in ministering with ACTION, both Short Term and Long term.**

From March 24-29, ACTION Canada will be hosting ACTION's annual International Council meetings, with some 40 individuals coming from our fields around the world. I am also in charge of the IT stuff, making sure everyone has access to power for laptops, Internet, video projectors, and photocopiers. **Do pray for the IC meetings, for unity, good health and weather, and a great time of fellowship, as well as the responsibilities each of us in the office has.**

Continue to pray for my finances—while there has been some increase, more is needed. Last month the timing belt on my car broke, requiring \$3700 to rebuild the engine, replace other worn parts, and get it back on the road—a large, unexpected expense. **Continue to pray for new people and/or churches to feel led to support me in my ministry.**
