


## Winter 2020



Two months later, I am mostly healed. **Please pray for complete healing.**

Financially, it has been an especially challenging year, with considerable, unexpected vehicles expenses and a loss of support. The shortfall amounts to about \$600.00/month. **Please pray for the Lord to move people to give to my ministry to bridge this gap.**

Margaret sold her condo for more than the asking price—we praise the Lord for that! **Pray for her as she ties up loose ends over the next month or so and moves permanently to Texas to begin a new chapter in her life. Also pray for her health issues, that she will continue to heal.**

Over the next 3 months, I will again be busy traveling in BC, Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba, attending and speaking at mission conferences in Bible Colleges, churches, and Missionsfests. If you would like a list of the events, so you can pray for each of them, I'd be happy to send it to you. **Please pray for traveling mercies, good health, and for God-ordained conversations at every venue, to recruit people for missions, and service with ACTION, both short term and long term.**

Thank you for your continued support. May the Lord use you mightily in your sphere of influence for Him.
