This resulted in increased food insecurity, malnutrition, and poverty. Food insecurity is defined as the condition of not having access to sufficient food, or food of an adequate quality, to meet one's basic needs to live an active, healthy life.

Hunger can also be viewed as a dimension of poverty. Without sufficient and sustainable incomes, families cannot access basic needs like nutritious food, clean water, or quality health care. Some of the causes of hunger include inequity, climate change, conflict, disasters, and emergencies.

### QUICK REALITIES ABOUT FOOD HUNGER

- 1 in 10 people suffer from hunger
- 3.1 billion people cannot afford a healthy diet.
- In 2022, an estimated 29.6% of the world's population —
   2.4 billion people were moderately or severely food insecure.
- 783 million people suffer from hunger around the world.
- 80 million more women than men were hungry in 2022.
- 85% of people facing hunger crises live in conflictaffected countries.
- 13.6 million children suffer from severe acute malnutrition.
- 2 million children die every year from malnutrition.
- 45% of all child deaths worldwide are from hunger and related causes.
- 1 in 3 children in low-and-middle income countries suffers from chronic malnutrition.
- Rising global food prices will cause 1.5 million more children to be undernourished.
- The war in Ukraine increased hunger for one-fifth of the global population, impacting 1.7 billion people.


### **Unity Kitchen**



## FIGHT RISING HUNGER IN UKRAINE

The war in Ukraine has pushed millions of people in its immediate region and others worldwide into deadly food insecurity. Roughly one in three families in Ukraine – 11 million people – are food insecure. You can provide critical food assistance to those affected by this devastating war.
