In many of the countries where we work, government institutions provide a free health policy for citizens. Unfortunately, the system of universal health care has several drawbacks, as it unequally impacts the most vulnerable. Some hurdles include deficient infrastructure, lack of resources, overloaded facilities, understaffed or absent specialists, constrained budgets, underequipped hospitals, insufficient training, inadequate care, distant locations, etc.

Worst Healthcare Systems

Here are 26 countries with the worst healthcare systems: Madagascar, Haiti, Republic of Congo, Niger, Papua New Guinea, Afghanistan, Mozambique, Liberia, Angola, Mali, Ivory Coast, Cameroon, Sierra Leone, Benin, Nigeria, Democratic Republic of Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Guinea-Bissau

Rural Communities

Less than half of the world's population live in rural areas. Approximately 76% of the developing world's poor live in these rural regions. Overall, 90% of the global rural population live in Africa and Asia. About 51–67% of the rural population have limited access to essential health services. Globally, this translates into an estimated 2 billion rural people without adequate access to essential health services. Unaddressed health challenges acutely affect those who live in rural, remote, and hard-to-reach areas.

Economic Crisis and Shortage

In Sri Lanka, the economic crisis resulted in a shortage of staff and basic medicine at public hospitals. Around April 2022, the cost of medicine increased by 40 percent. This forced many Sri Lankans to explore affordable alternatives or go without treatment.

Impact of War

In February 2022, the Russian forces destroyed 218 hospitals in Ukraine, 181 pharmacies, blood centers, and dental clinics, and 65 ambulances. The Russian military occupied hospitals because Ukrainian military would not fire back. Ever since, they've found landmines in functioning hospitals, where Russian forces planted during their occupation.

Access to Assistive Technology

Globally, more than 2.5 billion people need one or more assistive products. With an ageing global population and a rise in noncommunicable diseases, more than 3.5 billion people will need at least one assistive product by 2050, with many older people needing two or more. Manual wheelchairs increase access to education and employment while reducing healthcare costs.





HOST A MEDICAL CLINIC

Across Southern Asia, hundreds of thousands people cannot access health care in their rural villages. Mild ailments and preventable diseases plague the most vulnerable. You can help provide critical, life-saving medical care to the most vulnerable in India and Nepal today!



In Nepal, rural dwellers account for 49.7% of the population with poor health care access. Economic, geographical, cultural realities, and insufficient health care capacity impede their access to health care services.



India has the largest rural population with 893 million people. In rural parts where we serve, only 13% of the population have access to primary health care, 33% to sub center, and 9.6% to a hospital.

ServeNow empowers indigenous pastors across rural India and Nepal to serve the poorest of the poor. However, in these areas, there's a significant shortage of doctors. This is unlikely to change due to the challenges of poor housing, lack of education, and inadequate infrastructure in rural regions. These hospitals also face issues, with half the number of beds compared to urban facilities and often being the last to receive new equipment. These conditions have a devastating impact on local healthcare and the most vulnerable members of society. For instance, children under the age of five in certain rural areas have higher mortality rates compared to those living in urban environments.





ServeNow's staff, board, and volunteers are incredibly well-connected across
Southern Asia. Part of our network includes trusted Christian doctors and medical personnel, who help treat the most vulnerable.

ServeNow equips a local partner pastor with a medical kit. This first aid kit provides a collection of medical supplies and equipment to give immediate medical treatment, primarily injuries or mild medical conditions.



When you provide a medical kit to an indigenous pastor, it opens doors for an entire village to hear the Good News! You can help build a bridge for a local pastor to reach rural, tribal villages that are often against Christians.



Each medical kit costs \$500 per village. You can partner with 20 pastors by providing a medical kit. A gift of \$10,000 empowers the local church to serve their community and share about Jehovah Rapha, the Lord who heals.



IMPROVE QUALITY OF CARE THROUGH A MEDICAL CONTAINER

Advocate the highest quality of health care for the most vulnerable in Sri Lanka, Ukraine, and the Middle East. *ServeNow* partners with the Salvation Army of Sweden to receive free medical equipment and ship to vulnerable nations in need.

Sweden's world-class medical care is excellent, ranking 8th place globally. Every three years, the nation updates their medical equipment. So the tools and devices are barely used or brand new with the original packaging! All of the medical containers equipment is certified for consignment, sanitary, and fit for human use according to code.



For every dollar *ServeNow* provides in freight, this releases approximately 10 dollars in life-saving and needed medical equipment. Certificates and freight are the main expense, costing \$20,000 per container.





SPONSOR THE **DENTAL VAN**

Roma-gypsy health lags behind the majority of the population. This ethnic group has a significantly shorter life expectancy, higher mortality, and more at-risk to disease. Oral health has a major impact on overall health, especially pertained to your longevity and life expectancy.



Population of Bulgaria

The population of Bulgarians continues to decline steadily while the Roma-Gypsy population grows by 35,000 a year. The Romani people in Bulgaria constitute Europe's densest gypsy minority!



Inaccessible Dental Care

The Bulgarian government regulates accessing health benefits. But due to Romani's uncertain legal status and absence of citizenship, healthcare is nearly impossible. Some additional barriers include financial constraints, mobility, and not knowing the language.

For the last 31 years, Dr. Todor and Petya Zarev have served as pastors in Petrich. Near the Greek and Macedonian borders, their Baptist Church originally served the local Bulgarian community, but has become a Gypsy church. The Zarevs have gained a national reputation as effective leaders and teachers for the Gypsy churches and pastors.

In the summer, Dr. Todor works as a pro bono dentist in one of the poorest areas in Bulgaria. He's a fully qualified dentist, using portable equipment to provide basic dental care to the local people who cannot afford otherwise. We're proud to assist Dr. Todor by providing various supplies and materials.





ServeNow Bulgaria utilizes *The Basic Series* books as discipleship resources and training for the local church. Over 20 books are translated with several more in the pipeline. Ask how you can ensure God's Word in the Bulgarian and Roma population.



ServeNow Bulgaria purchased an ambulance and converted it into a dental van. To mobilize the van, it will cost \$3,360 or \$280 a month to serve those in need. You can help share Christ in practical way to the ever growing Roma population.
