2023 HIGHLIGHTS

ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM

Praise and honor unto our God! Batch 15 of our ALS Program, 3 learners from Elementary and 11 from Junior High School level, graduated last July 31, 2023 at C.P. Garcia High School. These are out-of-school youth and adults who were not able to complete basic education due to family situations and problems, bullying, the need to work at a young age, and other personal and financial problems. ALS provides them with a second chance at education, once they complete the program and pass the assessment, the Department of Education issues them a certificate of completion or diploma.



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

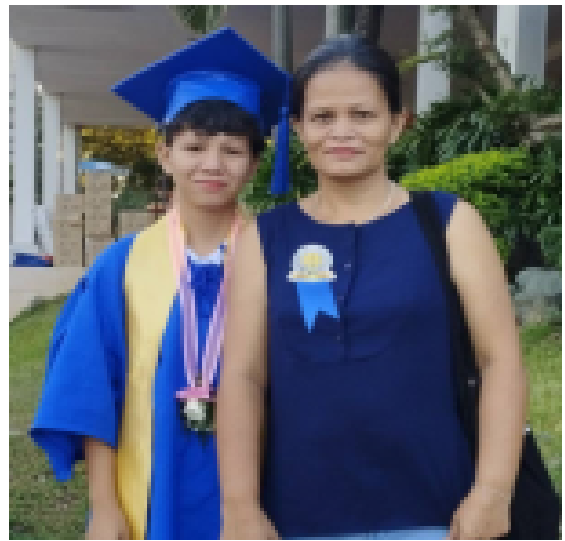

Ashley and Aldrin graduated from Elementary and are now enrolled in Grade 7.

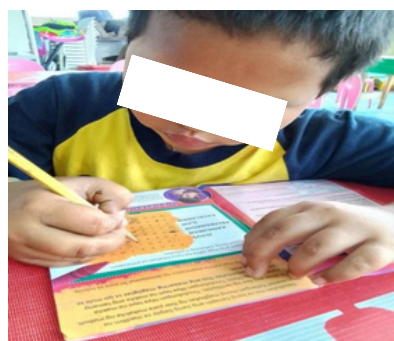


Arjay and Angelo completed ALS Junior High School and are now enrolled in Senior High. Carla graduated from Senior High School and is currently taking Criminology .

TUTORIAL PROGRAM AMONG STREET CHILDREN IN KATIPUNAN AREA

Last September of this year, we launched our tutorial program among street working children in the Katipunan area. We hold this program once a week in our barangay hall. These children go to school in the morning and work in the streets from 4 o'clock in the afternoon to 10 o'clock in the evening. Young as they are, they are bearing the weight of supporting their families' needs and their education by selling sampaguita garlands and bottled water. They also beg for food and spare change.

Through this program, we aim to provide supplementary assistance to further their learning. A more long-term and sustainable goal is to also encourage their parents to continuously support them as they finish their education so they can land a better job in the future. Most importantly, we have the opportunity to share Jesus Christ and His love to all children through this program. We are currently using the booklet from CEF/Child Evangelism Fellowship, Araw-araw Kasama Natin ang Diyos (Everyday Jesus is with us). Please pray with us, for our plan to have a livelihood training and sustainable project among their parents. Lord-willing, we are also planning to conduct the tutorial sessions twice a week. Let's pray that these children will be able to concentrate on their studies and leave the streets for good.

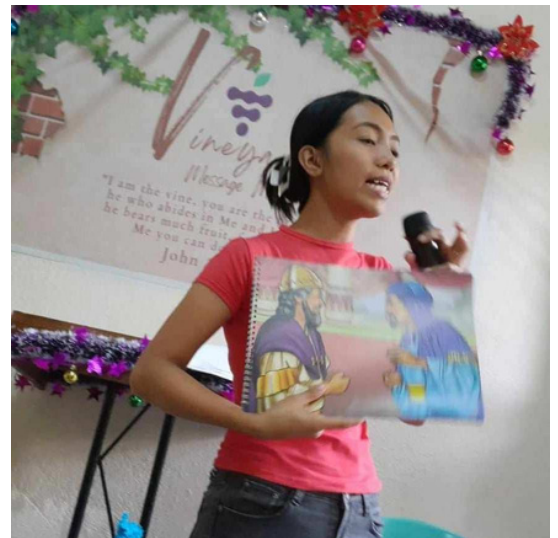
We have 20 partner churches from Metro Manila and Rizal that simultaneously facilitate the Evangelistic Christmas parties from Dec 15 to the first week of January 2024 with 1,300 street and community children and out-of-school youth. Some churches held their evangelistic parties during the last weeks of December. As of late, we are still waiting for other churches' program and activities. We ask for continuous prayer for the whole team as we minister and share the gospel of Jesus Christ to children and young people in different communities. Praise the Lord for this opportunity!

OTHER ACCOMPLISHMENTS/ THANKSGIVING AND PRAYER REQUESTS:

1. We praise God for families, children, and youth in the communities who received Jesus Christ as their Lord and personal Saviour. Most of them are now involved in the church and Bible studies.
2. For this year, we received 72 boxes (2,592 packs) of Manna Pack Rice from Feed My Starving Children Minnesota, USA and 21 Balikbayan boxes of Gleaners Mix Vegetable Soup including white and milk chocolates from Ontario, Canada for our feeding program. These boxes were sent to our partner churches in 6 regions. Praise the Lord! We were able to feed 1,673 children in partnership with 39 partner churches, schools, and communities.
3. Conduct of ALS classes which started last September 2023 is still on-going. Currently we have 29 enrollees, 9 from the Elementary Level and 20 from the Junior High School level. They are now preparing for their portfolio assessment and/or Acceleration and Equivalency test to be conducted possibly within the first quarter of 2024. We thank God for the opportunity to share them the Gospel during our weekly Bible studies and home visitations.
4. Last November 14, 2023, our staff had our first session of introduction to counseling with Chaplain Daneck Dang-awan. Sessions will be continued within the first quarter of 2024. Our aim is to enhance our skills in giving spiritual counseling and psychological first aid for our learners, children, scholars and parents under our program.

Prayer Requests:

1. We are praying for a bigger space for our community learning center. Pray for God's provision for this project. By January or February, hopefully, we can have time to visit and survey some areas in Cubao.
2. Pray for God's wisdom as we lead SCSF ministry. Please pray for our SCSF team of workers and Board of Trustees to continue to work together for God's glory. Pray for our partner missionaries Al and Sonie Tadeo. Continue to pray for God's provision to support our workers and projects.
3. Pray for a volunteer psychologist or guidance counselor for us to better provide help in the mental health aspect of our beneficiaries.
4. Pray for the whole team and partner churches that we can minister effectively to all street and community children and out-of-school youth. Pray for God's guidance in all our programs and projects. Pray for God's provision for SCSF Ministry and for all workers.
