



April 2017 Personnel Opportunities in Gulu, Uganda

Disciple makers – first priority, all training and mentoring will include integral discipleship; all long-term missionaries are expected to have experience making disciples who in turn make disciples. Those with little or no experience in disciple-making will be considered for short term and intern positions, but should prepare for involvement in discipleship relationships both before departure and while serving in Africa.

Operations Manager – train and oversee nationals in areas of bookkeeping, accounting (QuickBooks knowledgeable), payroll, mission business, licensing, taxes, government relations and regulations, immigration, personnel relations, equipment, vehicles and property management.

Pastoral Leadership Development trainers and organizers – equip and organize training coalitions for national pastors, train trainers, set up Bible school for pastors and Christian workers and a conference center in Gulu, and mini training centers in Northern Uganda, train church planters, equip pastors to serve refugees from South Sudan, train librarians and Christian literature workers.

***School Teacher trainer** – train local primary teachers in all subjects including music and art.

***Special needs teacher** – train local teachers to teach and understand special needs children.

***Physical Therapist** – train physical therapist and parents to empower and care for special needs children.

Christian Child Development trainer – train children’s workers to minister to children in crisis and their families as well as teach children’s workers in local churches. Oversee ACTION Uganda’s child sponsorship program.

***Nurse and other medical practitioners** – train and work with local nurses and medical personnel for ACTION’s school, sponsored children and their families.

Refugee & Crisis Response trainer – train and organize refugee and crisis response workers from local churches to minister among the 10s of 1,000s of refugees flooding in from South Sudan to northern Uganda. Network with other Christian, government and humanitarian groups to reach the least reached.

Appropriate Technologies trainer – train national staff and oversee vehicle maintenance, property maintenance and development, solar systems, IT systems, water systems, permaculture and other livelihood ventures.

*ACTION Uganda operates a Christian Nursery and Primary School for over 150 children, several with special needs. Also, our Family Strengthening Outreach Team regularly follows up 38 former Home of Love orphanage children (who are sponsored and attend other schools) and their guardians in Gulu and surrounding villages.
